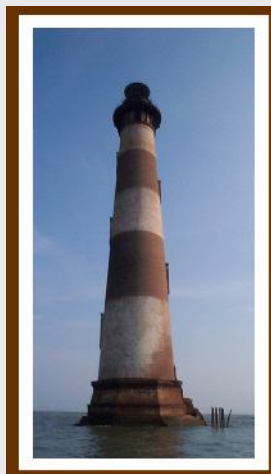
Study science in Charleston! This itinerary will include lessons in **agriculture, ecology, biology, and conservation.**
